Wolverine HOG and Charitable Activities

Did you know that over the past three years the Charity Fund has contributed over \$30,000 to charities that directly benefit local area children in need. The Charity Committee is very selective to locate charities that spend the majority of their funds on children services, and not on administrative services and salaries. As a result of selecting smaller local organizations, the donations made by your Chapter have had a significant impact on these organizations and the children they serve. These donations have provided summer camp for children with cancer, helped to provide prosthetics for children, wigs for kids with cancer, and more.

None of this would be possible without the significant contributions and efforts of our Chapter Members! Of course, all Members participate at a level that they are both comfortable with, and the amount of time they have to devote to these activities. But many members participate without even knowing they have. If you attend Meet & Mingle events you participated because the Charity Committee often negotiates a rebate of our expenditures as a donation back to the Charity Fund. If you had your bike washed, you participated; or if you attended Bertolini Good Ole Days, you participated. All of these activities and events help raise funds for future donations.

It is very important to note that none of your dues, and none of the Chapter budget, is used for charitable activities. The amounts expended come from the various activities and fundraisers held during the year.

In addition to the Chapter charity activity, many of our Members' have assisted with dealer sponsored activities that also supported our charitable efforts. Special thanks to Wolverine Harley-Davidson for their support of our specified charities.

So, are we a charity? No, of course not. But in the course of our planned activities, rides, events, etc. why not help out these local charities when we can? You, as a Member, choose how much you want to participate and are never under any pressure to participate at all.







Wolverine Chapter #1332 HOG®

Chapter Rewards Points Guidelines and Requirements*

Effective **May 1, 2017** Wolverine Chapter 1332 HOG® members will earn Chapter Rewards points for participating in Chapter events. This includes all open, member only and closed events and does not include public events advertised by the Chapter. Approved Chapter member cards are provided to members to record attendance at events and rides. Chapter Rewards points do not have any monetary value and are not redeemable for dues, merchandise or services.

Requirements

The following requirements are defined for members to earn points.

Must be a current active member of Wolverine Chapter 1332 HOG®

Must present an approved unique membership ID registered to the member at sign in

Sign in occurs at the prescribed time and place by an authorized member or representative

Point Schedule

Members meeting the above requirements will earn Chapter Rewards points as follows.

10 points for each non-riding Chapter event 20 points for each Chapter ride

Dealer Rewards Points

In addition to Chapter Rewards points, members will also earn equivalent Dealer Rewards points which can be redeemed per the Wolverine H-D Rewards points schedule and guidelines. All Dealer Rewards points are subject to approval by authorized Wolverine H-D representatives. This added value and benefit is provided by and may be discontinued at the sole discretion of Wolverine H-D and its management.

Sign in time and place

To accurately represent attendance and participation the following is defined as the sign in time and location for rides and events.

Rides - Sign in time and location are defined as staging location prior to kickstands up.

Events - Sign in time is defined as anytime during the event at the event location.

Data Privacy

All data collected is considered private and protected by our privacy policy. Your information will be used solely for Chapter and Dealer related business and will not be shared with any third parties. Any data collected and stored is secured and accessible only by authorized Chapter members or representatives to record attendance at Chapter events.
