

We practice together; using standardized methods, so that regardless of who is escorting any given group, we all know what each other's job is in any given situation. That common knowledge and practice allows us to be as safe as possible, and ultimately make for a safe and enjoyable riding experience for Chapter events.

This theory is not only useful for the type of riding the road crew does to escort rides. As a chapter member joining these rides, having a set and standard method of riding makes everyone more comfortable, safer, and ultimately leads to a more enjoyable ride. Much like the Road Crew practicing and riding together to hone these skills, you too can hone your skills by riding with a group, and with a standard set of methods and techniques.

The Wolverine HOG Chapter has been conducting G.R.E.A.T. Rides for quite some time. G.R.E.A.T. (Group Riding Elements and Techniques) They depart from the dealership, and travel to a local destination, where along the way we can practice the elements and techniques employed by our Chapter in our group rides. Prior to departing, there is always an in depth pre-ride briefing. This briefing details the hand signals we use, the formations we ride in, the route we will be taking, and most importantly WHY we do all these things. Our goal is to get every rider, whether they are new to riding or just new to the chapter, on the same page and comfortable in a group regardless of the size. We encourage participation from the newest riders to the most seasoned riders (and everyone in between), because lets face it, it's still a chance to go for a ride! So come on out the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of every month during riding season and go for a ride with some of your fellow chapter members!!!
