



Riding in the Autumn

Riding in the Autumn can be beautiful - especially with the leaves changing colors. It can also be quite chilly!

HD® recommends that we be prepared for the Autumn with head-to-toe riding gear that provides optimal comfort and versatility.

This can mean to layer clothing as well as to pack an extra sweatshirt or zip-up hoodie. By doing this, it is easy to remove or add a layer for your comfort.

As far as keeping your head and neck warm, you might want to consider a skull cap, neck tube, or balaclava.

A skull cap covers the top of your head and is available in a variety of styles. A face mask or neck tube covers your mouth and neck.

A balaclava combines a skull cap and face mask by covering the top of your head, mouth, and neck.

Other options for layering include base layer long sleeve shirt, as well as base layer pants. These will be thin enough to wear under clothing without adding bulk and will add extra warmth.

Safety Information



Even with layers of clothing, riding in the Autumn is definitely jacket weather.

Many H-D® jackets are functional jackets - meaning that they have special areas or pockets on the inside designed for body armor. Most common armor for a jacket would be back, shoulders, and elbows.

Body armor can be molded pieces of leather, fabric, plastic, or kevlar. This provides extra protection in case of *you-know-what* and is designed to be energy absorbing.



Armor will be rated as CE Approved and either Level 1 or Level 2. "CE" stands for "Conformité Européene", which means European Conformity or in essence, that it meets the established standards for body armor. Level 1 and Level 2 is the rating system - with Level 2 being more protective.

Keep in mind that when added to a jacket, body armor will add some extra bulk. So it might be useful to bring the armor when choosing the correct size of jacket.

Lastly, an important consideration for safety while riding in the Autumn is being able to freely move your arms, legs, torso and head while in your riding gear. It might be useful to test out your riding gear while sitting on your parked motorcycle to ensure that movements are easy and unencumbered.
